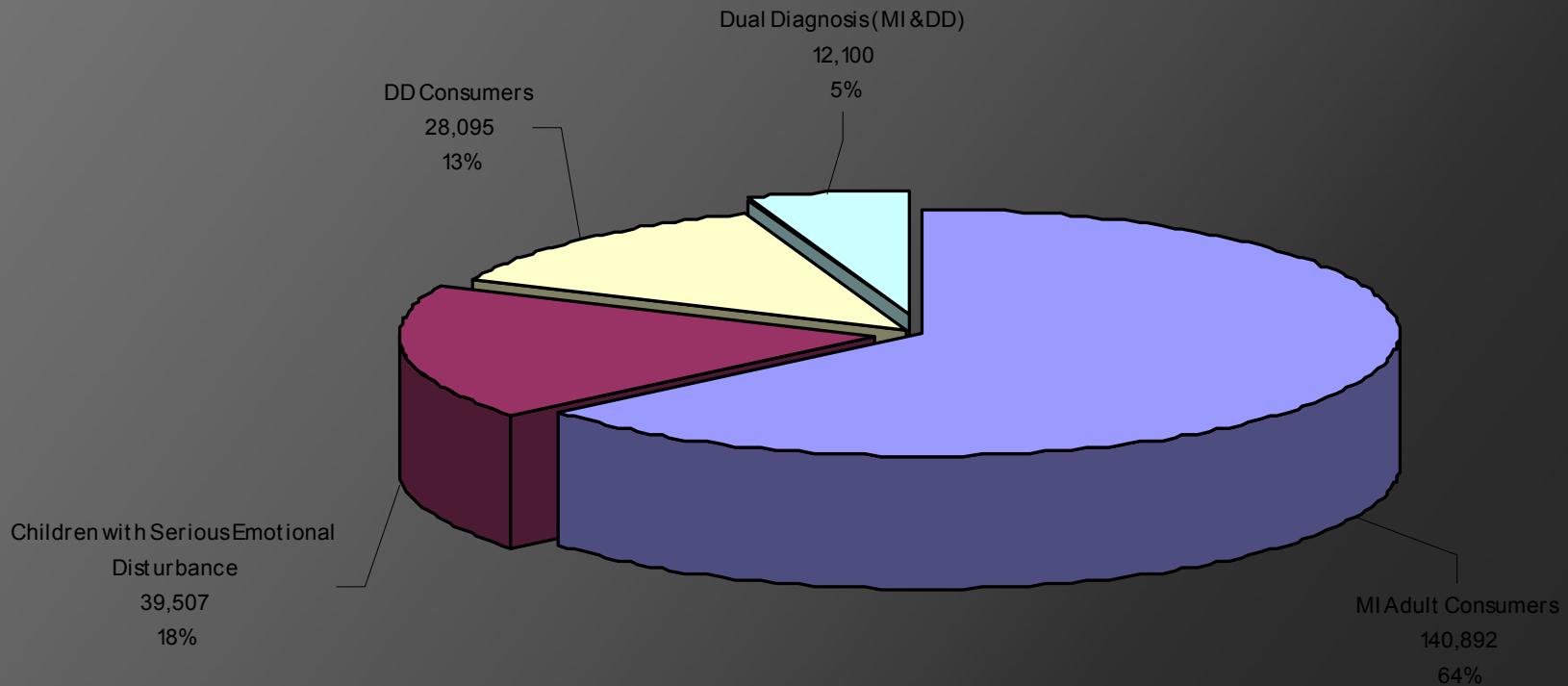

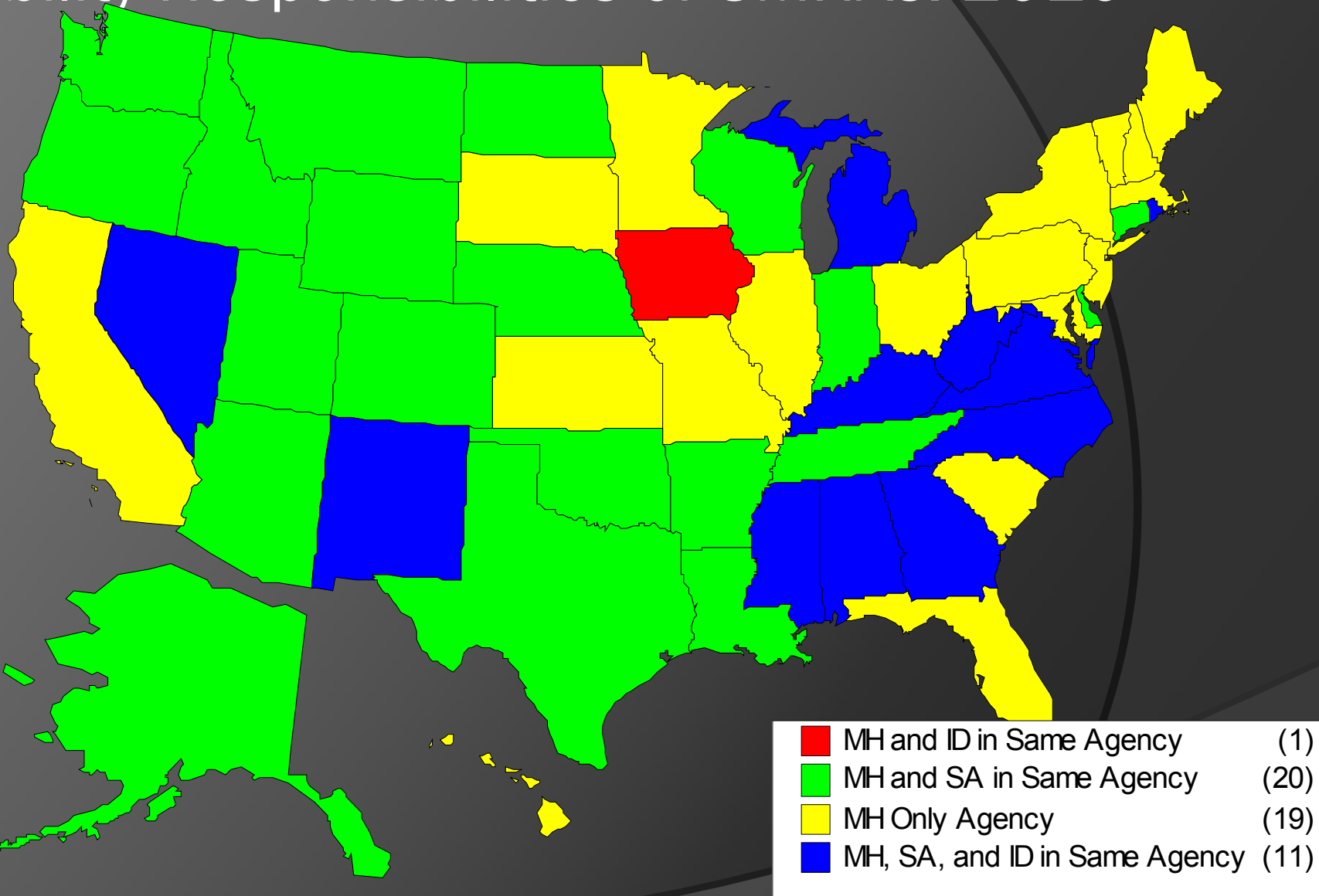

- Employment data sharing joint consumers

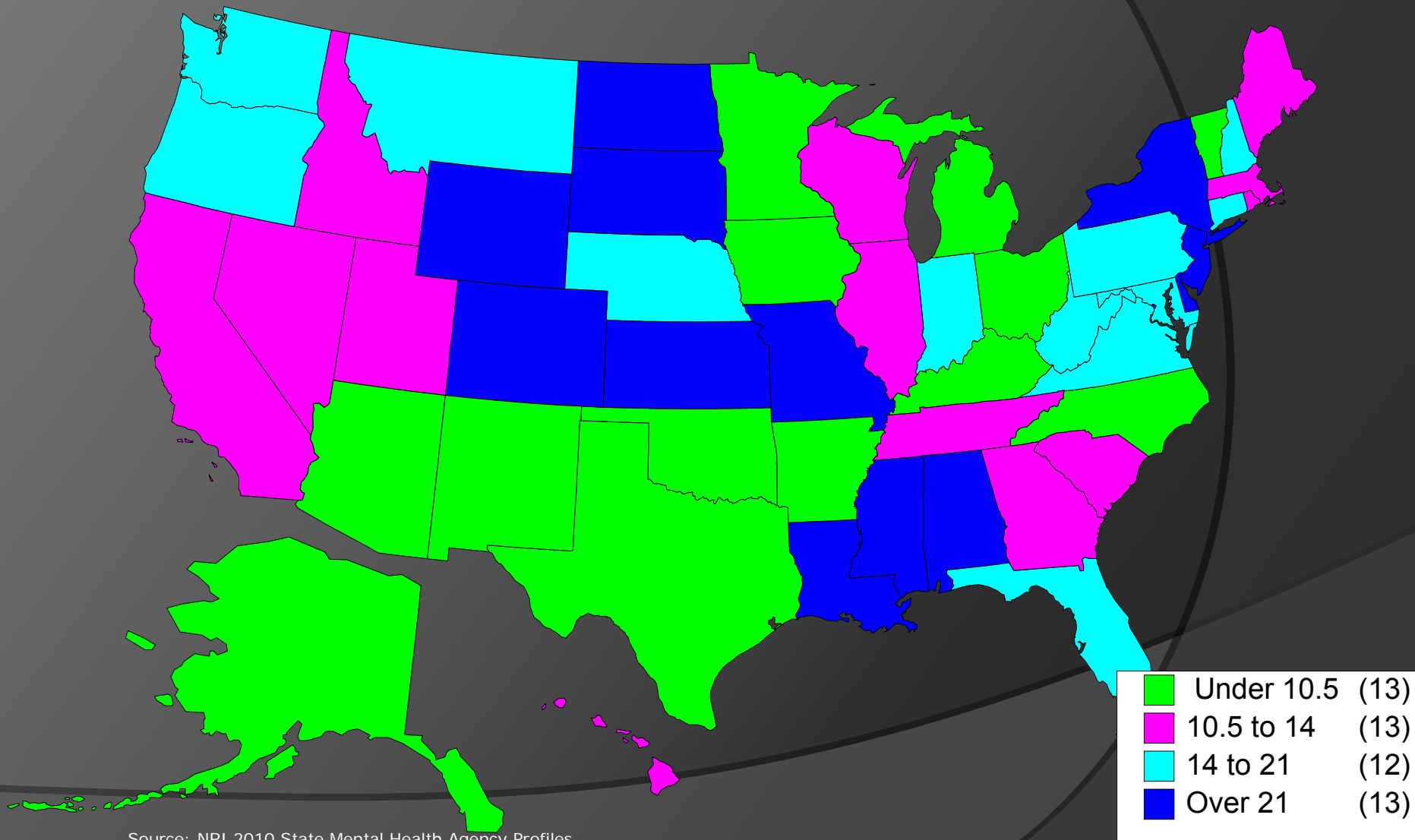
# Celebrating Growth and Success

- ◎ National Leader in Community Integration/Managed Care

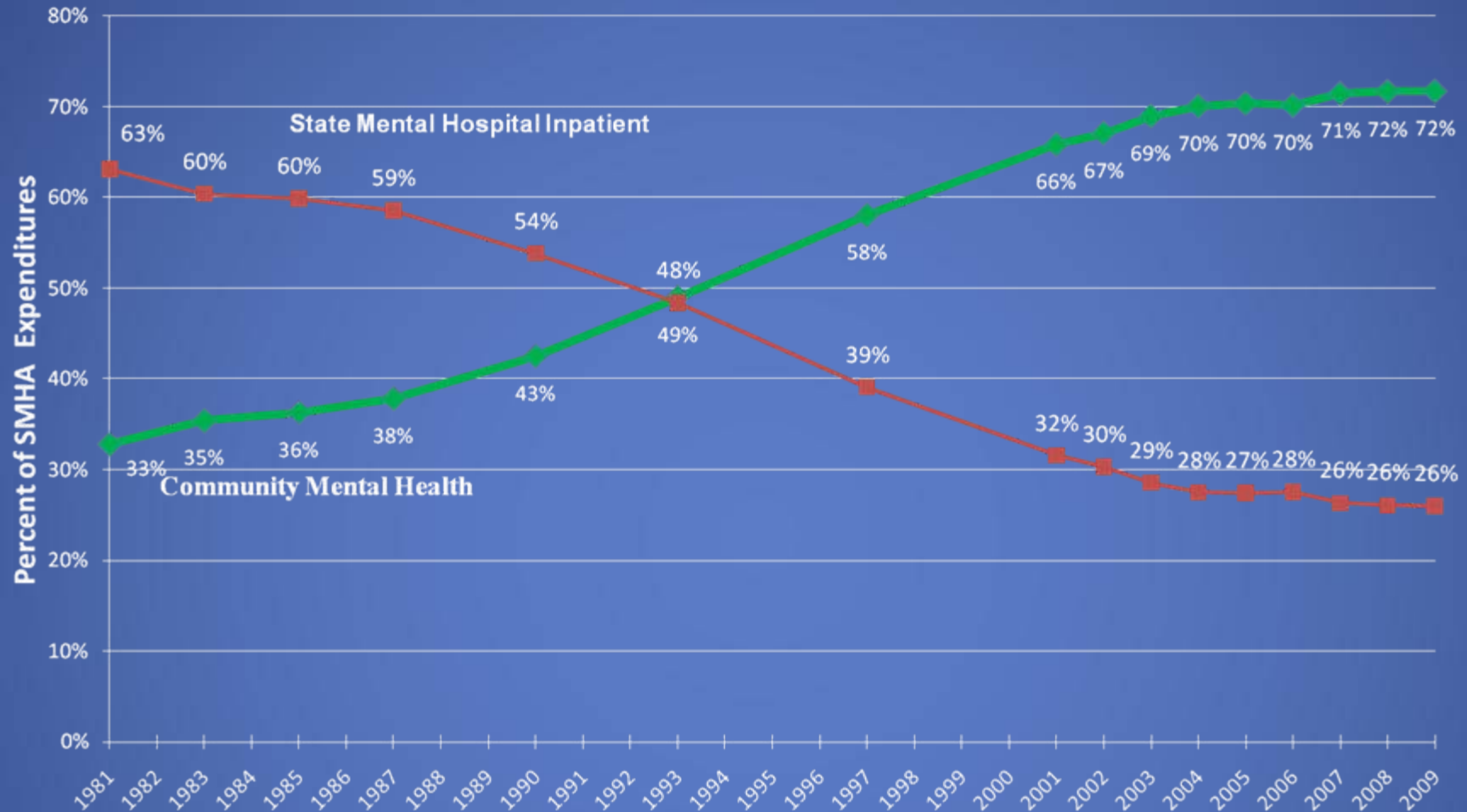
# Disability Responsibilities of SMHAs: 2010

# Current Activities

- ⦿ Budget

  - GF Reduction-Total \$8.48 million
- ⦿ Administrative Simplification (490)
  - Report/Action Plan June 1, 2012
- ⦿ Deemed Status (494)
  - Report/Action Plan July 1, 2012
- ⦿ Examining MDCH-BHDDA Structures and Processes to Streamline Cross Bureau/Office

# Current Activities

- ◎ Mental Health Workgroup Report 2008
  - From Governor's Health Message
  - DCH Facilitate Action Plan Meetings
  - Recommendations 1-4 (Pre-prison)
    - Improve Community System (courts, jails, mental health providers, training)
    - Diversion Programs, Jail Re-entry, MH Courts
    - Improve Management in Jails (identification, treatment, training staff)
    - Streamline/Standardize Info Sharing/Intake
- ◎ Dual Eligible Planning (Medicaid/Medicare)

# Current Activities

- ◎ 2011 Michigan Comprehensive Employment Services Grant Attained Priorities:
  - Increase Outreach & Partnership Employers
  - Multi-Agency/Earlier Implementation School to Work Planning
  - Collaboration Across Agencies & Departments
  - Implement Sustainable Data System
  - Strategies Remove Transportation Barriers

- 2011 Michigan Comprehensive Employment Services Grant Progress To Date:
  - Two Targeted Job Fairs (200 attendees, 15 employers, 4 jobs accepted from one event)
  - 2012 Job Fairs Planned
  - Growing Partnership (MRS, MCB, Department of Education, DHS, Michigan Works!, MARO)
  - Drafts- “Using Networking & Social Networking to Get a Job”
  - Draft-Statewide Employment First! Initiative
  - Two Transition Conferences-Joint Presentations
  - 14-Transition Age Placements-Project Search Model Detroit & Grand Rapids
